READ

- ◆ 1 Peter 1:22-25
- ◆ 2 Peter 1:19-21
- ◆ Isaiah 55:10-11



PRAY

- ◆ Thank the Lord for his enduring word and for the gift of knowing him by his word.
- ◆ Select a Psalm and pray through it as a family.
- ◆ Pray that God would send his word into our city.



TALK

- ◆ Talk about what is happening to the leaves right now— falling off and dying. Compare that to evergreen trees, which will keep their needles and stay green all year round. Talk about how God's word lasts, even when other ideas or sayings are wearing out and changing.

Sola Fide



READ

- ◆ Philippians 3:7-11
- ◆ Romans 3:21-26
- ◆ Proverbs 3:1-6



PRAY

- ◆ Thank the Lord for giving Himself to us as we open ourselves to Him in faith. God's greatest gift is *Himself!*
- ◆ Repent of our tendency to try to work our way to God.
- ◆ Pray for boldness to present the gospel freely to our city.



TALK

- ◆ Talk about your love for your family—how you love them unconditionally because they are your family. Discuss how God loves his people faithfully because we are *His* through Christ. Talk about how you can remind one another to run to God in the midst of failure.

READ

- ◆ Ephesians 2:1-10
- ◆ Romans 6:1-14
- ◆ 2 Timothy 1:8-14



PRAY

- ◆ Thank God for his great grace to undeserving sinners, ask him to fill your heart with grace towards others.
- ◆ Pray for one another asking the Holy Spirit to train you by grace for good works (Titus 2:11-14).



TALK

- ◆ Spend time together remembering your baptisms. Look at pictures, tell stories, and remind one another that God's grace came to you first, when you were still far off from him.

Solus Christus



READ

- ◆ John 14:1-6
- ◆ Acts 4:1-13
- ◆ Ephesians 1:3-14 (notice all occurrences of the phrases “in Christ” and “in him”)



PRAY

- ◆ Praise our Father for sending his Son to save us.
- ◆ Rest in Christ, who alone saves you and who opens the heavenly throne room to you.
- ◆ Pray for boldness to preach *Christ* to our city.



TALK

- ◆ Discuss the great *privilege* of prayer—how Jesus Christ opened the veil for us so that we can come to God our Father directly in him. And talk about the many ways people try to find salvation, emphasizing the teaching of Jesus that we come to the Father only in him.

READ

- ◆ Isaiah 43
- ◆ Psalm 96
- ◆ Romans 11:33-36



PRAY

- ◆ Begin your time of prayer by reading Psalm 96, and then take turns giving Glory to God for who he is.
- ◆ Begin each day this week with prayer offering your work or play to God for his glory.



TALK

- ◆ Talk together about ways that you can organize your time, decorate your home, or give yourself other reminders to look for opportunities to glorify God in your day-to-day lives.
